History: The Maine Sea Coast Mission’s scholarship program started in 1918. For over 90 years the Maine Sea Coast Mission has been supporting the educational efforts of students on coastal down east Maine. Our program is one of the few that will permit students to reapply for all four years of college as long as they meet our criteria.

Criteria: The recipient is to be selected according to the following:

1. Recipient must reside in the Mission’s service area and be a legal resident of Maine, plan to attend as a full time student to an accredited two or four Year College or university.
2. Each recipient chosen by the MSCM Scholarship Committee will be based on financial need, academic promise and character. (No one criterion is more important than another)
3. EFC (expected family contribution) may not exceed \$8,000
