



## 2019 Scholarship Re-Application

**History:** Since 1918, we have awarded more than \$2.5 million to 3,450 deserving students from Maine’s off-shore islands and coastal communities. Every year, approximately 25 new scholarships are awarded on the basis of financial need and academic promise. Because these scholarships can be renewed each year of a multi-year program, there are nearly 100 Mission scholars in any given year.

**Criteria for a re-applicant:**

- Have received the Maine Seacoast Mission Scholarship in the prior year
- Reside in the Mission’s service area and be a legal resident of Maine
- Attending an accredited two or four-year institution as a full time student
- Retain a minimum GPA of 2.5
  - Angus MacDonald Scholar must retain a minimum GPA of 3.5

Please provide:

- Transcript
- One Page Essay on your choice of:
  - Does Social Media create isolation?
  - Describe a topic or concept you found so engaging that it made you lose all track of time and why did it captivate you?

Mandatory to attend a Mission Scholars event

- Leadership Workshop for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year students (Mount Desert Island)- July 20, 2019
- Leadership Workshop for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4 yr students (Mount Desert Island) – July 21, 2019
- Leadership Workshop for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year students (Cherryfield) - August 2, 2019
- Leadership Workshop for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4yr students (Cherryfield) August 3, 2019
